

#### **Computer History Museum Timeline**

- 1975 Generations Exhibit with voice-slides, DEC Building-12 Lobby
- 1979 The Digital Computer Museum (TDCM) Founded
- 1982 TDCM becomes The Computer Museum (TCM)
- 1984 TCM Opens to the public
- 1990 Computer Milestones Exhibit opens
- 1996 The Computer Museum History Center (TCMHC) formed in Mt. View
- 1999 TCMHC becomes independent non-profit entity
- 2000 TCMHC becomes the Computer History Museum (CHM)
- 2002 CHM reaches halfway mark in cash and pledges towards \$100 million capital and endowment campaign
- 2002 CHM purchases land and building in Mt. View, CA
- 2003 CHM Alpha Phase Open House
- 2005 Chess Exhibit
- 2007 Off-site warehouse purchase
- 2008 Babbage Engine 2 Exhibit
- 2009 Timeline Exhibit OPENS



### **Museum Overview**

- Collection
  - World's largest collection of computer artifacts
    - Objects: 20,000 artifacts
    - Software: 5,000 items representing several terabytes of historical data
    - Media: 20,000 still images & 5,000 moving images
    - Documentation: Approx. 5,000 linear feet of historical data
    - Ephemera: 1,000s of individual items
    - Oral Histories: 100+ personal stories from computing industry pioneers

# **CHM Collection – by the numbers**




moving images	5,000 titles




